**Paul R. Williams** (1894-1980) was the first African American member of the American Institute of Architects (1923) and AIA's first African American Fellow. He designed approximately 3000 buildings during his career, including the original St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in Memphis and many homes for Hollywood stars. He overcame barriers of racism to become one of America's most admired and successful architects. Through his example, this course addresses ways to teach your students about architecture and the built environment.

*How does architecture communicate what we value?*

*What does architecture say about our community?*

*Who is allowed to define our public spaces?*

*How can the built environment contribute to sustainable communities?*

*How can we design integrated curriculum that addresses visual art standards and engages students in architecture in the built environment?*

- Deepen your skills and competencies in teaching architectural concepts.
- Increase knowledge of the built environment
- Develop strategies for teaching 3-D art, design and architecture.
- Learn about the work and influence of Paul R. Williams, his success in overcoming obstacles, his appropriateness as a role model for underserved youth and to elicit thoughtful inquiry on the role of architecture and its societal impact on the livable environment.

Hands-on integrated discovery of concepts and processes, including architectural scavenger hunt, design activities and exploration of teacher resources. Facilitators include representatives from AIA & Art Museum University of Memphis.

**Fellowships:** Art teachers may apply to be a PRW Fellow. Fellows will receive \$500.00 honorarium. Expectations include:

- full attendance at the 3-day summer institute
- develop an art lesson OR art museum education plan
- submit the art lesson/museum education plan to the online database of architectural resources.

Fellows who teach the lesson in the 2009-2010 school year and submit revised lesson plan, teacher reflections and images of student products will be eligible for transportation funds to take their class to see the Paul R. Williams exhibition at the Art Museum of the University of Memphis.

**Course Credit:** 3-credit graduate (ART 6020) or undergraduate (ART 4020).
